**SCHOOL VULNERABILITY ASSESSMENT TRAINING**

**Course Dates:** TBA

**Course Time:** 0800-1700 Three Consecutive days

**Course Location:** Host provided

**Course Length:** 24 hours + 1 hour lunch per day (lunch not provided)

**Course Description:** This course provides attendees with twenty four hours of training in conducting all-hazards vulnerability assessments of schools. An actual physical assessment of a school will be conducted. This training may assist schools with their required comprehensive Safe School plan per California Education Code Section 32280. Topics covered include:

- Scope of the problem
- Actual case studies
- Conducting an assessment (classroom discussion and onsite)
- Threat Analysis Process (TAP)
- Risk analysis and risk quantification
- Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED)
- Introduction onto explosive and their effects
- Targeted shooters
- Techniques/options to increase security
- Emergency Response Plans
  - 3-Tiered lockdowns
  - Dual gate reunification
  - Shelter-in-place
  - Reverse evacuation
- School Bus Safety
- Integrating with Emergency responders (Police, Fire, EMS)
- Conducting a briefing on potential security enhancements.

**Target Audience/Discipline:** This course is designed for police, fire, emergency management, school officials, teachers, school staff, security personnel, and other public safety officials with responsibility for school safety and security.

**Cost:** All training and course materials are free to eligible attendees. Participant travel and overtime expenses will be the responsibility of the attendee's agency.

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
