In response to these increases and the significant jump in the number of claims, ASCIP committed to the development of the CAARE (Child-Anti Assault Response & Education) Initiative to support the child sexual abuse prevention efforts of their districts. This session will explore The CAARE framework and the four key pillars critical to effective and efficient implementation of prevention strategies and safeguards that have proven to be effective and can be customized for all districts.



As the Executive Director of Property and Casualty Programs at ASCIP, Reshan is responsible for leadership and project management for a broad range of strategic organizational initiatives and coordinating ASCIP's efforts to maintain and enhance programs and service offerings. 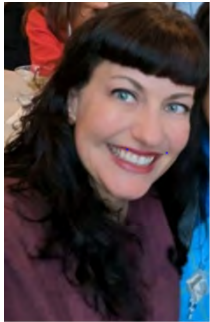
