- There's so much of it we take it for granted
- What is it?
- Why so much of it?
- Why should we care?

#### What is it?

- vulgar slang
- noun: bullshit
- stupid or untrue talk or writing; nonsense.
- *verb*: **bullshit**; 3rd person present: **bullshits**; past tense: **bullshitted**; past participle: **bullshitted**; gerund or present participle: **bullshitting**
- talk nonsense to, typically to be misleading or deceptive.

#### What is it?

- Both a term of abuse and a phenomenon, category of speech and category of action
- A lack of respect for the truth
- Humbug: deceptive misrepresentation, short of lying, especially by pretentious word or deed, of somebody's own thoughts, feelings, or attitudes.

### Pretentious

Attempting to impress by affecting greater importance, talent, culture, etc. than is actually possessed.

## Nonsense

- Not lies, but exaggerating the notion of feeling bad in a very specific and particular way
- This exaggeration and phrasing is clearly unconnected to a concern for the truth not wrought with care
- Lack of respect/concern for truth/clarity
- Child's play vs adulthood

#### Nonsense

- Exaggerated
- Outrageous
- Ridiculous
- Not legitimate

- Facebook, Twitter, TickTok
- Fake news

Nonsense can be harmless, when it's not does that make it bullshit?

## Nonsense/Bullshit

- Unconnected to a concern for the truth = bullshit/nonsense
- Mindlessness without attention to facts or bothering to take accuracy into account

• It's not about making a mistake that should bother us, but the lack of care about getting it right when it matters: indifference to how things really are is the essence of nonsense and bullshit



Clearly unconnected to the truth

#### Bull vs Bullshit

The Do Nothing Democrats should be focused on building up our Country, not wasting everyone's time and energy on BULLSHIT, which is what they have been doing ever since I got overwhelmingly elected in 2016, 223-306. Get a better candidate this time, you'll need it!

- Tasks that are pointless or unnecessary
- Trivial, insincere, untruthful talk or writing, nonsense
- Hot air without substance or content, emptied of all informative content, empty talk
- Talk that is not hot air/bullshit, demands facts or substance the bullshitter is in a way making a <u>bluff</u> as to what he is saying or representing

#### Bluff

- To bluff ones' way through by talking nonsense
- Bullshit is a kind of bluff, closer to bluffing than lying
- Both bluffing and lying are misrepresentations/deceptions
- Both bluffing and lying are false or fake
- The essence of bullshit is not that it is false, but **phony**

## Phony

- Counterfeit = phony
- Something is a counterfeit because of how it's made, not because of what it is (a purse is still a purse)
- So although bullshit is produced without concern for the truth, it need not be false
- Lying = to lie you must know what the truth is, or think you know in order to craft the falsehood/lie

## Lying vs Bullshitting

- It is impossible to lie unless you think you know the truth, producing bullshit requires no such conviction
- The bullshitter is neither on the side of truth or false the primary interest is in getting away with what he says

• The liar rejects the truth and its authority, the bullshitter pays no attention to it. Therefore, bullshit is a greater enemy of the truth than lies.

### Bullshit is Unavoidable

- Circumstances may require someone to talk without knowing what they are talking about
- Society believes citizens should have opinions about everything
- Belief that sincerity overrides correctness (feeling vs knowing)



## Marketing and Bullshit

Marketing targets feelings and emotions, not necessarily truth





## Sincerity's Role in Bullshit

#### Correctness

- Truthful to reality

#### Sincerity

- Truthful to the facts Truthful to feelings of or about reality
  - You can be sincere without being correct
  - Sincerity is bullshit if based on falsehoods

## Navigating the Bullshit

- Look for motive
- Where is the substance?
- Trust but verify
- Do the work

Do you know what you are talking about or are you just full of bullshit? Who are you and why should I believe you?

In today's political climate bullshit isn't too far removed from misinformation, disinformation, and/or rhetoric

You have to do the work to get through it

#### DAPPR Test

- Date; unclear, out of date, within five years
- Author: unclear, unrelated, credentialed
- Publisher: blogs, unknown, scholarly journal, government
- Purpose: personal, entertainment, persuade/influence, unbiased scholarship
- Relevancy: research related to topic

## Consequences of Bullshit

- Loss of credibility
- Loss of trust
- Subjective overrides objective
- Truth becomes irrelevant
- Reality/facts become malleable
- The world ends

## Bullshit is the Enemy of Gravitas

- Dignity, seriousness, solemnity of manner
- Composed or serious manner, worthy of respect

"Perhaps we can inject bleach to kill the COVID virus, almost like a cleansing"

"Sandy Hook is a hoax" – Alex Jones

The "dust up" that occurred on Jan 6 – Jack Del Rio

Desire the truth, even if you are wrong



## What Does This Have to Do With Safety/RM?

- HR action, "It's close enough"
- This claim is as bad as the Catholic Church
- OSHA is going to come in here & shut us down!
- Evidence of IIPP effectiveness is no CalOSHA citations
- There's no coverage for that
- You can't put a sticker on a hard hat
- Covering up/minimizing exposure

The Safety/Risk Management profession must pursue truth, clarity, transparency and objectivity to maintain respect as a profession

"arm personnel so we can stop the shooter in seconds"

## Professional Judgement

- Expert opinion testimony (based on experience and education)
- Required in many circumstances
- Creating hypotheses or theories
- Speculating about a situation or circumstance (vaping deaths, mask use, COVID vaccines, COVID deaths)

Without careful attention and concern for the truth, professional judgement becomes nothing but bullshit, hot air, nonsense

Avoid the bullshit – do the work, learn the facts, learn to think critically, be prepared, or keep quiet!

If we lose the bullshit meter, then even nonsense can become truth

Bullshit: see through it, stand above it, don't spread it around!
