General Safety in Special Education: Situational Awareness – Our General Safety in Special Education presentation which delves into de-escalation techniques, effective communication, and personal safety.

Equipment Safety in Lifting and Transferring – Discusses safety for both staff and students when lifting and transferring for toileting, floor work, transitions to other equipment, etc.

Best Practices in Special Education Transportation – Provides information regarding the safe transport of students with special needs.
