Evidence Based Medicine (EBM) has been, for the most part, reluctantly accepted by the WCAB. Instead, they focus on what is considered usual and customary in the eyes of the physician. Unfortunately, this sometimes runs into nonsensical opinions on what is work-related. This, compounded with the very small percentage needed to prove causation, has created a California Work Comp fiction of industrial diagnoses costing employers millions of dollars. This presentation discusses the pitfalls of our current system, a comparison of Work Comp Medicine and Real World Medicine (EBM) and how to inject Evidence Based Medicine back into the WCAB so we can reduce all costs associated with inflated reports, diagnoses and impairments.



Ted Hanf is a principal in the law firm of Kegel, Tobin & Truce, a workers' compensation defense firm which represents employers and insurance carriers in workers' compensation and related matters. He has presented at conferences of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the American Public Health Association, RIMS, PARMA, COSIPA and CSIA.

Dr. Mahoney is the founder and Director of Epidemiology Resources. The company's mission is to provide an evidence-based assessment of causation and apportionment in occupational and environmental matters. She has worked for state and local health departments, federal government agencies, the aerospace industry, health maintenance organizations, universities, and she has been a principal investigator on research projects both privately and publicly funded.

Understanding Serious Willful Misconduct cases - Labor Code 4553 provides for a 50% increase in the Workers' Compensation benefits, where the employee is injured due to serious and willful misconduct of the employer and may allow a 50% decrease where the employee's serious and willful misconduct causes their injury. Employers may not insure against their possible liability for the 50% additional compensation, but their Workers' Compensation insurance carrier may provide insurance against the expense of defending any suit brought by an injured worker alleging the employer's serious and willful misconduct. This session will clarify your understanding and provide basic steps to protection against S&W allegations as well as when and how to assert an S&W against an employee.
